

Registering for a Polar Plunge event

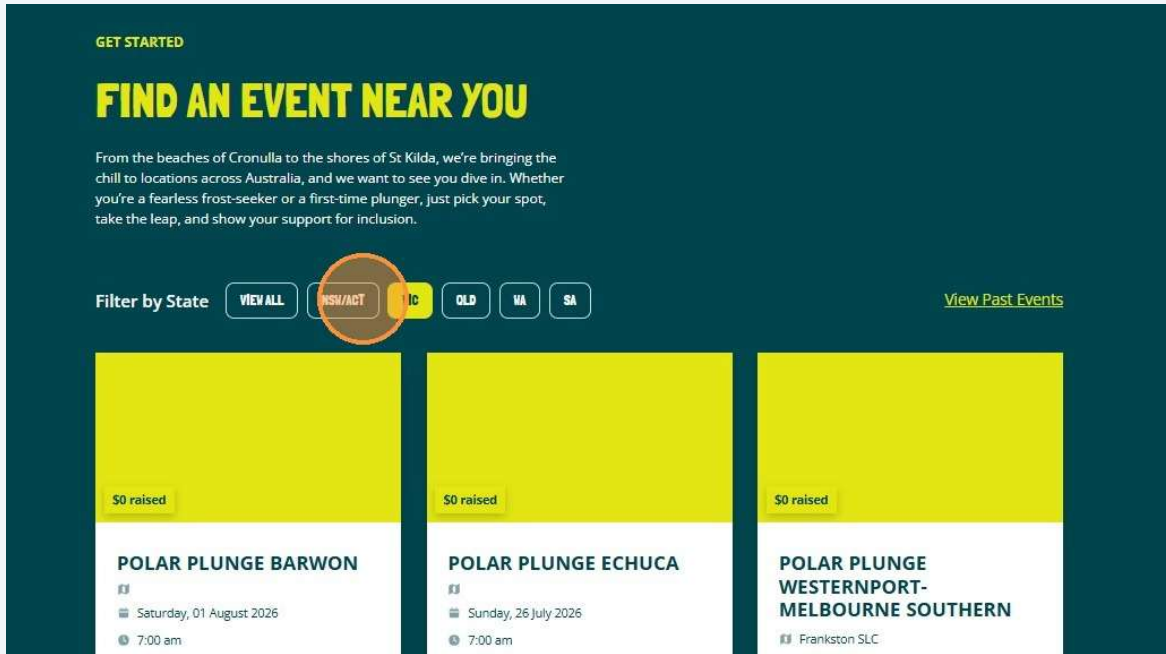
Learn how to register for a Polar Plunge event. This guide walks you through creating/joining a team, setting fundraising goals, and finalizing your registration and payment.

- 1 Click "FIND AN EVENT".



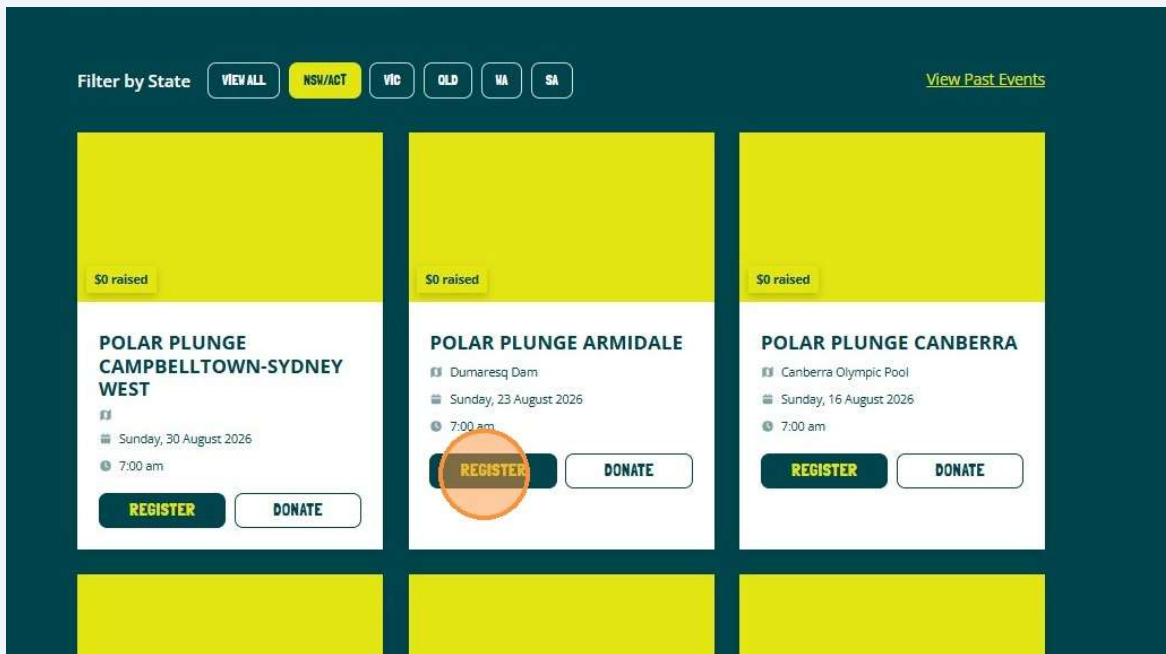




